

With the number of "Baby Boomers" moving in to the area to retire, we see an opportunity to make connections with this generation.

We have been livestreaming our services for the past 12 months, and have noted some interesting growth in the number of people "tuning in". This is another area for us to explore.

We also note the huge time pressures on the traditional Sunday morning time slot, and would like to explore ways we might grow connections with families for whom "weekend time" is really precious.

#### C3 How has the congregation changed in the past two years?

Covid has affected all of us. Some have not returned to worship and regular activities. We now livestream most services. The Cooma church was closed in April 2022, and members from there are now attending at Kyabram. Overall, the numbers attending worship at Kyabram has remained stable, as new folk have also begun to attend.

#### C4 What changes and developments are anticipated in the next three to five years?

As with all aging populations, we would expect frailty and mortality will reduce our numbers somewhat.

# **D** The Community

#### D1 Describe the wider community in which your ministry is located.

Kyabram is a community of around 8,000, situated in a rural landscape where dairy production, orchards, and market gardens flourish. All the processing occurs in the Goulburn Valley area. New housing estates are now accommodating people (mainly retirees) from Melbourne seeking a more affordable retirement. Kyabram is in good proximity to a number of larger rural cities (Shepparton 35 minutes, Echuca 35 minutes, Bendigo 75 minutes). Kyabram is 2.5 hours from Melbourne by road, with good rail connections from Bendigo and Shepparton.

## D2 What makes this an enjoyable place to live?

Kyabram is big enough, and yet small enough to be comfortable in most areas. We have a good shopping precinct, excellent aged care facilities, with good regional hospitals within 35 minutes. Our climate is very congenial, with all 4 seasons being experienced each year, without the extremes. We have excellent sporting facilities with golf, bowls, etc. The local public schools have a good reputation, with a Catholic school in town, and other church schools within commutable distance.

#### D3 What are the points of stress and pain in the wider community?

Homelessness

Disengaged youth – substance abuse, some vandalism

Accommodation – lack of availability as Rochester recovers from the flooding event of 2022.

Family breakdowns

Domestic violence

Shortage of staff for all areas - schools, farming etc. ie. skilled and unskilled

Higher education possibilities TAFE, apprenticeships have moved to Shepparton

Ageing population – retirement destination – places pressure on medical services

#### D4 How closely does your congregation reflect the demographics of your local area?

Just looking at worship attendance, we are skewed towards the older age groups. However, we connect with a much wider age group over all of our activities. Kyabram is predominantly Anglo, and so is our congregation.
