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Time for Change - Rethinking the use of property

Faithful use of property over decades

- Landscape has shifted
- Opportunity to reassess whether existing property is being used to maximise mission



The MfM Program and Fund

- Providing income, preserving capital
- Taking burden off local church for property management
- Transparent and understandable



How does Program work ?

Responsible Body recognises that property is an underutilised resource



- In discernment with Presbytery determines to sell and invest in MFM Fund
- Responsible Body receives regular, flexible and simpler income
- Opportunity for long term investment capital growth through investment unit holdings

Further income used for wider missional purposes

How do we get a higher return ?

Managed by U Ethical

- **Residential Rental Property**
 - Underwritten net rental return
 - Premium "top-up " of 0.5% (Metro) and 0.75% (Regional)
 - Total return cap of 2.25% (Metro) and 2.5% (Regional)

Non-Residential Property

- Provides a premium to investors over the return that would come from a property sale and investment of the shared sale proceeds in an IOMF
- Provides flexibility of use for income distributions



The MFM Fund - where does the money go?

A shared approach...

- > distributions to Responsible Body
 - Greater \$ than alternative PSP options or current net rental income
 - Give more flexibility of use in their local context
- > distributions to wider Church mission resourcing
 - Presbytery staffing and needs
 - Assembly grant
 - Congresses
 - wider Church missional grants
 - Synod missional funding
