

Giant Bubble Wands

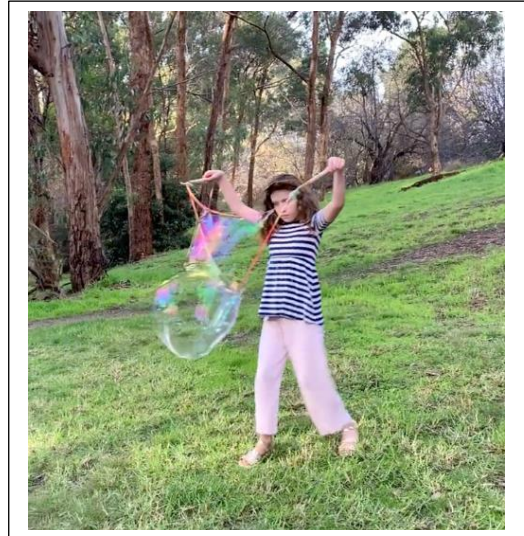
Note: Blowing giant bubbles works best in weather where the air is a little moist and cold so Pentecost time in southern Australia is the perfect time for this activity!

To make a bubble wand you will need:

2 pieces of wooden dowel
2 cup hooks
2 pieces of thick chord or elastic (One piece longer than the other)
A couple of nuts or washers to weight the bottom string.

To make the dish soap you will need:

A bucket
12 cups of water,
1 cup of washing up liquid (Fairy works best)
1 cup of cornflour
2 tablespoons of Baking Powder.
Mix all the ingredients up in a bucket and get ready for some bubble blowing fun!
